Kindly note that as per the guidelines received, school will re-open from 15th Sept. 2021 for classes IX & X. We have followed all the guidelines and SOP given by the Government.

Sessions will be online as well as offline.

Timing: 09:00 am to 12:10 pm

Students will be allowed to attend school only after written consent of their parents. So, before sending your ward to school, you are requested to give your written consent if you wish to send your ward to school (Format of the same is sent along with this circular).

Either you can write the content of written consent letter on one page in the same format or take print, sign and send photograph of your written consent to your ward's class teacher by tomorrow 1:00 pm.*

Send Hard copy of the same along with your ward when he or she joins the school.

You are requested to go through the following rules and regulations before giving written consent:**

Provide written consent for your children to attend school if you wish to send your ward to school.

Ensure that your ward comes to school wearing a mask and sensitise them not to exchange masks with others.

Disposal face masks are to be disposed safely.

Encourage ward to wear full-sleeved clothes to minimize the interaction with any public surface.

Parents may take care not to send their ward to school if the child is not feeling well. In such case, ward should study in parent's supervision.

Avoid sending ward to school in case of any of the family member is suffering from cough or fever.

School Transportation will not be available.

While Dropping and picking children from school you all also need to maintain physical/social distancing to avoid Covid-19 infection and ensure that you wear a mask.

Your ward is expected to practice physical/social distancing at all times once she/he leaves home.

Students need to maintain minimum 6 feet distance from others.

More than four students mustn't gather in school campus, instruct your ward accordingly.

Clean and sanitize your ward's uniform and other belongings daily.

Provide sanitizer and two clean small napkins/clean cloth daily with your ward for wiping hands.

Canteen facility will not be provided as lunch break will not be there in the schedule.

No material (writing material, books or notebooks) to be exchanged in any case by your ward.

It is advisable that parents/guardians download the AAROGYASETU APP and let your ward commute only when the App shows safe and low-risk status.

Regarding the Standard Operating System followed for re-opening of the school, parents' role, process of school functioning and submitting the written consent, you are requested to take utmost care.

PN: Your consent regarding 'Ward Attending the School (Yes /No)' has to be communicated to the class teacher in written format by tomorrow.
